Company Profile

Pro-Safe Professional Linens was founded in 1987 by Laura Bradford. While working for a local dentist, she developed covers to fit equipment and furniture that was too difficult and time consuming to sterilize. Production moved from her dining room table to the Mesa County, Colorado, Small Business Incubator that fall; Pro-Safe was the first tenant in that facility.

In 1997, Clinicovers, a division of a company based in Montrose, Colorado was purchased. This merger expanded the customer base, added several items to the product line and additional new employees.

In 2001 a relationship with an importer to the EU was formed with Loser and Company of Cologne, Germany. Loser and Company purchases high quality products from more than 15 companies outside of the EU; they market and distribute the products to Dental distributors within the European Union. In response to this interest, ProSafe applied and was granted the certification of use for the CE mark on all the products sold abroad. ProSafe began attending the International Dental Show in Cologne in 2006 on a regular basis.

A major purchase of new equipment was made in the summer of 2016; an ultrasonic bonding and welding machine used to manufacture the high volume, single use products. The process is faster and gives a cleaner finished look to the products. No thread or adhesive is used in the process.

In 2018 ProSafe purchased the inventory of a technically superior fabric from Vestagen. This company manufactures Vestex fabric; garments constructed with the Vestex material has been tested and approved for use by the FDA*. ProSafe has an exclusivity agreement for the use of this material for the dental and dialysis markets throughout North America.

Customers include: national distributors for medical and dental products, Public Health Facilities, individual doctors and dentists, dental hygienists and assistants and teaching facilities throughout North America, dialysis clinics and long term care facilities. ProSafe also performs contract manufacturing for regional companies. Design and engineering is provided as well as production.
